



ABOUT *LEADERSHIP AGC*

The anticipated future growth of the built environment in the greater Houston region, coupled with its ever-changing and diverse demographics, underscores the importance and need for developing an informed and forward thinking generation of leaders for the commercial construction industry.

Leadership AGC is seeking those individuals interested in developing and enhancing their skills as leaders as well as increasing their overall knowledge of our industry's place in the community. In addition to enhancing their professional and civic networks, program participants will also learn what they can do to actively participate and to ultimately become an influencer in the affairs of the industry and the community.

IS *LEADERSHIP AGC* FOR YOU?

Ideal candidates for the Leadership AGC program are emerging leaders currently working in the commercial construction industry in greater Houston and meet the following admission criteria:

- Are you an individual that holds a management position or the equivalent and has been identified to move up in his/her company?
- Are you an individual that is involved in the construction industry outside of his/her company?
- Are you an individual that is employed by an AGC Houston member firm?
- Are you an individual that is committed to Leadership and the AGC and will readily share knowledge gained through the program with company colleagues?
- Are you an individual that can meet time commitments of this program?

HOW DOES *LEADERSHIP AGC* WORK?

Leadership AGC is designed to ensure that the greater Houston commercial construction industry is well represented in the future in key leadership positions, both inside and outside the industry. *Leadership AGC* participants meet approximately once per month from January 2022 – January 2023. The program includes lectures, simulations, group discussions, panel presentations, field trips, roundtable discussions, in-person and virtual events, and community projects. Each session will focus on an integral aspect specific to Houston and the surrounding region.



Past programs have included sessions pertaining to the following:

- Introduction to Leadership and AGC Houston
- Professional Development: Skills and Knowledge Development
- Community Service and Charitable Giving
- Texas Medical Center/Thermal Energy Corporation or TECO
- Port of Houston
- AGC Texas Building Branch and Legislative Issues Program
- Leadership and Teambuilding Development
- Roundtable Discussions
- Owners Panel Discussions

Leadership AGC is governed by AGC Houston through its Board of Directors, Construction Leadership Council, and the Construction Futures Committee.

COMMITMENT TO LEADERSHIP AGC

A commitment to participate in *Leadership AGC* represents not only an obligation to the individual and to his/her company, but to the group of participants engaged in the program.

The program's success is directly linked to group engagement. Therefore, it is very important to consider the time commitment needed to participate. To graduate from *Leadership AGC*, participation rules will be strictly enforced. Those rules can be found in the *Summary of Course Requirements* portion of the application.

Please note:

While all eligible individuals are encouraged to apply, depending on the volume of applicants for the program in any given year, no more than **two people per company** will be allowed in any one class of *Leadership AGC*.



RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration, applicants should be employees of an AGC Houston member firm, and be able to meet the financial and time commitment. Applicants may be subject to personal interviews. Applicants will be awarded entry into the program starting in the fall of 2021.

A. ELIGIBILITY

1. Individual holds a management position or the equivalent and has been identified to have the desire and ambition to move up in his/her company.
2. Individual is employed by an AGC Houston member firm.
3. Individual is committed to **Leadership AGC** and will readily share knowledge gained through the program with company colleagues.
4. Individual and his/her company can meet time commitments of the program.

B. REQUIREMENTS

1. The Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all the following items are received as **one packet** to AGC Houston by **December 1, 2021**:
2. Completed Application and supporting documents with registration fee of **\$2500** to be paid by employer upon acceptance in the program.
3. Completed Application and supporting documents sent electronically in a PDF document to charlene.a@agchouston.org.
4. Three 150-word letters of recommendation from your (1) Employer (2) Business Colleague (someone outside of your company) (3) Personal Contact (someone outside of your company and not a family member).
5. One 150-word Personal Letter of Commitment (A statement acknowledging the current course commitment and future commitment to the industry).
6. Current resume or *curriculum vitae*.
7. All applications must be signed by candidates and sponsors. Application deadline is **December 1, 2021**.

C. PROGRAM ACCEPTANCE

1. The program may be limited to no more than two people per company per Leadership AGC class as the class is limited to 20 participants.
2. All applications are reviewed by the Leadership AGC Planning Committee, and the applicant may be subject to participate in a panel interview. The Committee will consider each applicant's interest and involvement in construction and his/her community, involvement in AGC Houston and a proven track record of employment achievement.
3. Applicants will be notified on or before **December 17, 2021**.



D. PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

1. To obtain the maximum benefit from Leadership AGC, a participant is required to attend all program sessions. For the program to have meaning and be beneficial, this will be strictly enforced.
2. Upon approval and acceptance into the program, participant will receive advance notification of all class dates.
3. The orientation retreat is critical to the success of the Leadership AGC experience; it is the first activity of the program. Attendance is mandatory for each participant.
4. Upon approval of the application, participant will be notified and receive the retreat location. It is mandatory that the participant stay on-site and in his/her assigned room for the overnight stay.
5. Program participants are expected to assume leadership roles in the community service project with a local charity. LAGC participants will lead, coordinate, plan, and execute all aspects of the charitable project.

G. COST

1. The cost of the program is \$2,500 and will be paid by employer upon acceptance into the program. Tuition covers fees, course materials, luncheons, socials, orientation and retreat and group transportation when needed.
