What is Leadership AGC?

Leadership AGC is a program designed to increase the awareness of potential AGC leaders by giving them an intensive experience that encompasses a broad scope of community and construction industry concerns.

Is Leadership AGC for you?

Leadership is for mid-level employees who work in the greater Houston Commercial Construction industry and have the potential to become a future leader within their organization.

How does Leadership AGC work?

Leadership AGC is designed to ensure that the greater Houston commercial construction industry is well represented in the future in key leadership positions, both inside and outside the industry. *Leadership AGC* will be experienced through eight educational sessions that includes lectures, simulations, group discussions, panel presentations, field trips and community projects.

What are the benefits of this program?

In addition to enhancing their professional and civic networks, program participants will also learn what they can do to actively participate and to ultimately become an influencer in the affairs of the industry and the community.

What will the program cover?

Leadership AGC will offer a full roster of educational and useful events designed for the Houston-area young construction professional who will become a future leader in our chapter. The eight-session series will connect **Leadership AGC** members with leaders in the construction, development, medical, industrial, political, and educational arenas.

What is the commitment to Leadership AGC?

In order to obtain the maximum benefit from Leadership AGC, attendance is mandatory for all sessions.

How long is the Leadership AGC program?

Leadership AGC is a 12-month program that will consist of monthly classes/experiences in either a full-day, eight-hour format or a half-day, four-hour format. Upon acceptance into the program, each participant will receive an annual calendar with all dates.

What is the cost of Leadership AGC?

The \$2,500 tuition covers all associated fees, course materials, luncheons, excursions, socials, and group transportation. See the application for specific payment details.
